"Mikis Theodorakis" Orchestra was created in May 1997 by musicians-collaborators of the Composer, who were familiar with his work. Their first appearance took place in June 1997. Since then, they have performed many concerts, collaborating with both recognized as well as new artists. Concerts in theaters, music stages, stadiums and open spaces throughout Greece, from Athens to the most remote villages of the region, as well as many countries abroad. In addition, they have organized and taken part in various concerts, in collaboration with symphony orchestras and choirs, often under the direction of the Composer. The goal of the Orchestra is to promote, as completely as possible, the work of Mikis Theodorakis. They attempt to achieve this goal in various ways, such as concerts, performances, television appearances and recordinas.

CORFU'S CHILDREN - YOUTH CHOIR "ST. SPYRIDON" PRSENTS THE DIVINE LITURGY OF SAINT JOHN CHRYSOSTOM COMPOSED BY MIKIS THEODORAKIS



"Ag. Spyridon" Choir was founded in September 2023, in the context of the newly established homonymous Society. Under the guidance of maestro Christina Kalliaridou, the choir consists of the following departments; Preparation, Children- Youth's Choir, Women's Choir. The pedagogical aspect of the act of choir singing is emphasized, in order to promote vital and lifelong musical education in the island of Corfu. Christina Kalliaridou belongs to the Specialized Teaching Staff (STS) of the Department of Music Studies of the Ionian University and is responsible for the «Children, School and Youth's Choir". Children-Youth's Choir "Ag. Spyridon" has conducted concerts and has also participated in Divine Liturgies set to music by Mikis Theodorakis. Children-Youth Women's Choir has recorded works of their repertoire, which are expected to be released.





ARSENAL

BY MANOLIS ANDROULIDAKIS

With his personal album "Myrtia" (2016) as a starting point, which consists of solo guitar adaptations of Mikis Theodorakis' works, Manolis Androulidakis performs the Great Composer's works, with stylistic precision and moments of exceptional skillfulness. The recital will include, among other Mikis Theodorakis' works, "The Neighbourhood of Angels" with virtuoso butcher's dance, «Zorba's dance» as if played by two bouzoukis, the melodic «Ser-

pico», the lyrical «Beautiful city» and the riveting «Antonis» of Mauthausen.

MANOLIS ANDROULIDAKIS

Honors licentiate in Composition and Guitar, with an honors degree in Harmony, Counterpoint, Fugue and Orchestration of wind instruments. He also studied 5-year Monodia and bassoon. As a guitarist, he has performed in Greece and in America, China, Canada, Europe, as well as in all the Balkan countries. He has collaborated with many Greek Artists and participated in several records, the outstanding ones being «The Bitter Saturdays and a Serenata», as a conductor, by Theodorakis – Papadopoulos

and «March of the Spirit» by Theodorakis – Sikelianos, under the direction of the Composer. His rich oeuvre includes, among others: Two Aegean chords for quitar. Five sketches

chords for guitar, Five sketches for guitar and string quartet, Suite for bassoon and piano, Three Preludes for piano, Monotony, in poetry by K. P. Cavafy, for bathyphon, cello and piano. He teaches guitar and musical theory at the New Conservatory of Thessaloniki.

KONSTANTINA VIDALAKI

Konstantina was born in Chania and belongs to the new generation of rising Greek pianists. He started piano lessons at the age of five and from a young age he has excelled in many competitions and been honored with many scholarships. She graduated from the Hellenic Conservatory with the highest honors - Piano Diploma with Honors and First Prize - she continued her studies at the Hochschule für Musik. Theater und Me-

dien Hannover and completed her master's degree with the highest honors in 2022. As a soloist, she has performed in internationally renowned concert halls around the world, at important festivals in Greece and has collaborated several times with orchestras such as the Hanover Symphony Orchestra. In 2020, the album «Aprés une rêve» was released.
